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# RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee payable to the Federation in respect of the championships is Rs. 5000/- for each Team Event
2. Entry fee of Rs. 1000/- per player per event will be charged for open events from such players who are not members of the team. Those institutions who are not participating in the Team events are eligible to send **two entries** with the normal entry fees and the rest of the entries will be with extra entry fees. The entry fee for extra entry will be Rs.3700/- per player.  
  
Doubles: Players who are already part of the team there is no entry fees. But other players who are participating in the Doubles events have to pay an entry fee of Rs 1000/- per player
3. The entry fee as per 1 & 2 above should be remitted to the federation through the online payment system.
4. Boarding & Lodging Charges: Participating Institutions will make their own Boarding and lodging arrangements for their team members.
5. All events shall be held under the laws and regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
- 5.a The following Events will be conducted
  1. Men's Team
  2. Women's Team
  3. Men's Singles
  4. Women's Singles
  5. Men's Doubles
  6. Women's Doubles
  7. Mixed Doubles
6. Team Event: The competition shall be conducted in two stages.

## Seeding of the Teams

The seeding of the Teams will be decided on the sum total of the ranking points of the best 3 players in the team

- Stage 1** All the teams shall be divided into four groups i.e. A, B, C and D and shall play on round-robin league basis. Top two teams from each group will qualify to Stage II
- Stage 2** The Draw for the II stage will be taken out as follows:  
In Stage II, the winner of group A and B will be placed in draw position 1 and 8, the winner of group C and D will be drawn between position 4 and 5. The runners up will be drawn in the remaining places in opposite halves from the winners of the same groups.  
Stage 2 will be held on knock out basis to determine the Champions. There will be no position match for position 3 & 4.

All the Matches in the team Championships shall be of best-of-5 games.

### **Team Match: Playing system**

(1) A team shall consist of 3 players.

(2) The order to play shall be A v/s X, B v/s Y, C v/s Z, A v/s Y, B v/s X.

### 7. Individual Events:

#### **THE PLAYING SYSTEM & SEEDING RULES FOR INTER INSTITUTIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024**

**MEN & WOMEN:** Players who are ranked within the top 50 of the ITTF Singles World Ranking list as of the date of the first draw will be seeded first and the rest of the seeding will be as per the latest National Ranking as of the date of the first draw. (This is as per the decision of the AGM dated 19<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

Seeding for the doubles will be determined on the sum total of the ranking points of the players forming the doubles pair.

Nominated players and pairs of the same Association shall, as far as possible, be separated according to the following principle

Associations shall list their nominated players and pairs in descending order of playing strength, starting with any players included in the ranking list used for seeding, in the order of that list.

The entries ranked 1 and 2 shall be drawn into different halves and those ranked 3 and 4 into quarters other than those occupied by the first two.

Remaining entries shall be separated only in groups and in the first round of the main draw, but not in further rounds.

### **Seeded players will be drawn as follows**

The entry ranked 1 shall be placed at the top of the first half of the draw and the entry ranked 2 at the bottom of the second half, but all other seeded entries shall be drawn among specified places in the draw, as follows:

- The entries ranked 3 and 4 shall be drawn between the bottom of the first half of the draw and the top of the second half;
- The entries ranked 5-8 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered quarters of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered quarters;
- The entries ranked 9-16 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered eighths of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered eighths;
- The entries ranked 17-32 shall be drawn among the bottom places of the odd-numbered sixteenths of the draw and the top places of the even-numbered sixteenths.
- The rest of the entries will be drawn at random among the vacant positions in the Draw.

#### **Direct to the Main Draw:**

Men's Singles/Women's Singles:

Top 16 Ranked Players

**Singles Events:**

All singles events shall be conducted in two Stages.

All players, except the top 16 ranked, players in Men and Women, will be drawn in groups of 3 or 4 players where they will play the league. One player from each group will qualify for the second stage which will be held on a knockout basis. All matches in the first stage shall be decided by best-of-5 games and all matches in the main Draw shall be played in the best-of-seven-games from Semi Finals onwards

**Doubles Events:** The Doubles events shall be conducted on a knockout system with all matches played in best-of-five games format.

8. The following shall be entitled to enter:

All the affiliated (who are not in arrears) Institutions shall be eligible to enter one team each in Men's & Women's team categories

Each team shall consist of a minimum of 3 players and maximum of 5 players in case of Men and Women Teams . All the States & Institutions may nominate maximum of two entries in Men's Doubles, two entries in Women's Doubles & 4 entries in Mixed Doubles.

The state Associations are also eligible to send entries in the Men's Singles, Women's Singles event as per the norms for National Ranking Tournaments

TTFI will have 32 wild card entries, if required.

9. The open events of the Inter-Institutional championships will be treated at par with National Ranking Championships and Players of State Associations are also eligible to participate in open events and the player's performance will be decisive for ranking (ranking points will be 1.5 times of the regular points.)
10. The Championships will be held from 24<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> November, 2024

12. The participants in the championships will have to find their own conveyance from their lodge to the playing arena and back.
13. The complete draw and programme for the championships will be put up on the Notice board at the venue and shall serve as the only official intimation to the competitors regarding the programme and time of play. All authentic information regarding the championships can be had from the Organising secretary/Competition Manager of the Championships.
14. Umpiring will be done in English Language only.
15. In view of organizational difficulties, the order of play will not be altered even if the captains mutually agree, unless it has the final approval and consent of the Competition Manager/Referee and the Organising Secretary.



16. The Captains of the team scheduled to play at a particular time, shall report to the Chief Referee or his appointed deputy at least 40 (Forty) minutes before the time fixed for their matches and teams not present at the time scheduled for their match are liable to concede a walk-over to their opponents.

Should a team captain not attend the toss on time, the opposing team will have the right to choose ABC or XYZ. For the team not at the toss, the referee on duty will put players in order of ranking as follows:

Any protest or appeal on any point of law may be made only by the Captain or, if he is absent or playing, by authorised representative of the team.

17. **Online Entries:** The entries have to be submitted online by logging on to our website [ttfi.org](http://ttfi.org) and the event page. Each State Association/Institution has already been provided with a User ID and password. No entries will be accepted through mail or any other communication. No entries can be entered after the deadline for final entries, i.e. 16<sup>th</sup> November for Institutions and 18<sup>th</sup> November for State Associations up to 1200 Hrs. Change of entries are permitted up to 20<sup>th</sup> November till 1200 Hrs.

As a special case, this year we are permitting the Institutions who are taking part in the Team championships to change their composition of the Teams at the Manager's meeting. But the player who is included in the Team should have already entered for the Championships.

18. **The First stage Team draw will be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November,** (time and venue will be notified later). Each Institution from which entries have been received is entitled to be represented by one person duly authorised by the Institution. The draw for the top seeded players will also be held on the same time. The draw for the first stage of individual events will be notified later.
19. Entries will be accepted only through affiliated Institution/State Association of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from Individual players will not be accepted.
20. Entries will not be accepted from such Institutions which have not:
- (1) Complied with the rules and regulations of the TTFI in respect of Affiliation fee, Associate Fee and in the conduct of open tournaments and/or annual championships. Each Institution should pay an Affiliation Fee of Rs. 50,000/- each year which falls due on 1st April every year.
  - (2) If not complied with the decisions of Annual General Meeting of the TTFI held in previous years despite clearing all the arrears.
21. The Managers' meeting will be held at on 23<sup>rd</sup> November (Saturday) at 1600 Hrs at the Conference Room, Chandigarh Lake Club, Near Sukhna Lake, Sector 1, Chandigarh

22. All the players participating should have registered themselves with TTFI for the year 2024. Entries of unregistered players will not be accepted. Institutions are requested to send the registration form of those players who have not registered so far for 2024 with a Registration fee of Rs. 500/- for new Registration and Rs 500/- for renewal
23. The Opening ceremony of the Championship will be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> November (Saturday) from 1830 Hrs onwards at Chandigarh Lake Club, Near Sukhna Lake, Sector 1, Chandigarh followed by dinner
24. Players who have already represented an Institution at the beginning of the season 2024 cannot represent another Institution in Team Championships in the Inter Institutional Team Championships 2024. However they can play the singles representing the current Institution in which they are employed. Players who are representing an Institution (Team Championships) in this year's Inter Institutional championships are not eligible to represent another Institution during the year in the Senior National Championships 2024.
25. The organising committee will be preparing the accreditation cards for all participants. The entry to the venue is open only to the persons having proper accreditation cards. All players have to attach their latest photo while submitting the entry on line. The coaches/Managers of various teams have to submit their details with photograph to the organising committee by E mail
26. The closing ceremony will be held at 1900 Hrs on 29<sup>th</sup> November (Friday) at Chandigarh Gold Academy, Behind Sukhna Lake, Sector 6, Chandigarh followed by Dinner.
