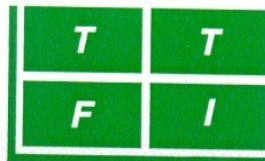

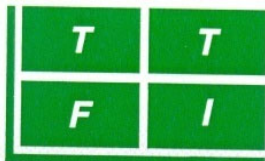

**RULES & REGULATIONS**

**1. ENTRY FEES**

A sum of Rs.3000/- is payable to the Federation by each Association/Institution towards entry fee for team events. There is no additional entry fee for YBS U 15/YGS U 15 Singles/Doubles for the players who are part of the State Team for the respective Events.

Entry fees will be charged as follows for the Youth Under 13 and Under 11 Events.

Entry fee for YBS U13/YGS U 13: Rs 800/- per player each for participating in the Singles/Doubles

Entry fee for YBS/UGS U 11: Rs 700/- per player each for participating in Singles Events

The Extra Entry fee will be Rs. 3200/- per Singles entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-15 and Under 13 while it will be Rs 2200/- per Singles entry in Youth Girls/Boys Under-11.

**2. System of Play:-**

a) Team Events (Youth U 15)

The Team Events will be conducted on Corbollian Cup format. Each team will consist of minimum 2 players and maximum of 4 players. The team events will be best of 4 singles and 1 Doubles. All individual matches in the Team events will be determined by the best of 5 Games.

Order of Play shall be :

A Vs X

B Vs Y

Doubles

A Vs Y

B Vs X

Team events will be conducted in two stages. In the first stage all teams (for the purpose of ranking of the teams, the sum of the ranking points of two best players of the team will be taken into consideration) will be divided in groups of 3 or 4 teams and they play the league matches. Two teams from each group will qualify for the second stage which will be held on a knock out basis to decide the Winner. There will not be any position match for positions 3 and 4.

**Clothing**

The players of a team taking part in a team match, and players of the same Association forming a doubles pair, shall be dressed uniformly, with the possible exception of socks, shoes and the number, size, colour and design of advertisements on clothing.

3. Events

a) The following events will be conducted:

All the singles events will be played in two stages:

Stage-I: All the players (except the top-eight ranked players in YBS U15, YGS U15, YBS U13, YGS U13) will be divided into groups of 3 or 4 players in each group. They will play one another in a round-robin league format to determine the order of position within each group. All the group league matches will be of best-of-five games. In YBS/YGS U 11, all players have to play the league matches.

Stage-II: Players finishing in the first position in each group, and the top-eight ranked players in the YBS U15, YGS U15, YBS U13, YGS U13 will play according to the single knockout system. Players finishing in the first position in each group in YBS/YGS U 11 will play the single knockout system. All the Stage II matches will be of best-of-five games,

.The schedule of play is planned as below, and may be altered, if necessary.

Boys under 11,13 and 15 should report on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2026, and Girls Under 11,13 and 15 should report on 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2026

4. Hospitality Charges:

Each state association will pay a sum of Rs.600/- per day for each player, one manager, one coach towards hospitality Charges and the maximum people eligible for subsidized hospitality are 24, including one manager and one coach per gender. For extra Coach/Manager @ Rs.1000/- per day per head will be charged (inclusive of both boarding and lodging)

Hospitality will include:

- a) Accommodation at a place provided by the host association, and Boarding for Boys from Lunch on 22<sup>nd</sup> March to Breakfast on 27<sup>th</sup> March. Boarding for Girls from Lunch 27<sup>th</sup> March to Breakfast on 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2026
  - b) Boarding shall include Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner. All other charges levied will be extra and to be borne by the participants.
5. If the accommodation provided is far away and more than a kilometer, the hosts will make transport arrangement from Hotel to Stadium and back.
6. There may be three sessions of play at least every day.

7. Entitlement of entries:

Each state association can send a maximum one team each in Youth Boys U 15 Team Event, Youth Girls U 15 Team Event, Four entries each in YBS U 15, YGS U 15, YBS U 13, YGS U 13. Two entries each in YBD U 15 , YGD U 15, YBD U 13, YGD U 13, Two entries each for YBS U 11 and YGS U 11. (Please note that only the top four ranked players in U 13 and U 15 are eligible to participate in the respective Doubles)

**Extra Entries:** Each state association is entitled for extra entries (Singles only) in each of the categories

TTFI can consider 32 wild card entries, in Singles events, if and when required.

8. All the events will be held under the rules & regulations of the International Table Tennis Federation and as adopted by the Table Tennis Federation of India.
9. Stag Global (Roma) Tables, and ITTF approved balls will be used for the Championships
- 10.. **The closing date for receipt of entries online is 8<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 . No entries will be accepted after this deadline.**
11. **Open draws for team event will be held at Venue on 22<sup>nd</sup> March for Boys team event and on 27<sup>th</sup> March for the Girls team event, commencing at 1100 Hrs. The Technical Committee will conduct the draws. The time for draws for singles events will be informed at the venue.**
12. Entries will be accepted only through an affiliated unit of the Table Tennis Federation of India. Direct entries from individual players will not be entertained.
13. All the associations/institutions will inform the Organizing Secretary at least 10 days before the commencement of the championships the date, time and the mode of transport by which their teams will be arriving at Gandhidham
14. Gluing and smoking are not allowed inside the hall.
15. Participation certificates will be issued to all taking part in the 87<sup>th</sup> Sub Junior and Cadet National Table Tennis Championships-2025. Those who make it to the medal rounds will get merit certificates. The certificates are issued by SAI through DigiLocker.

## OTHER INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

---

**Online Entry:** All entries have to be submitted online through the TTFI website portal. If new players are to be added to the data base, please key in the details and obtain the TTFI ID before entering the names in the online portal.

**Sub Junior Boys/Girls Events (Under 15)**

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2011

**Cadet Boys/Girls Events (Under 13)**

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2013.

**Hope Boys/Girls Events (Under 11)**

These events are open to only those players who are born on or after 01.01.2015.

**Age Eligibility**            The respective affiliated units shall certify the correctness of the date of birth of each entrant

**Registration Form:** and all players should submit their registration form (if not submitted earlier to TTFI this year) in the prescribed format, duly attested by the Head of the Institution/School in which the player is studying and counter-signed by the respective State Association secretary. The copy of the birth certificate should also be attested by the State Secretary. In case the birth registration is not done within a year with the authorities concerned, a court order has to be obtained.

**All players should bring with them their Original Date of Birth Certificates for verification.**

### INFORMATION FOR PLAYERS

By entering the event, players agree to abide by all TTFI rules and regulations, including that of the Organizing Committee. All associations and individual players agree to be under the auspices of the TTFI and its agents in all matters concerning television coverage, video, internet, webcasting, motion picture coverage, and photographic coverage of any kind. Participants release all rights or rights held by their agents/sponsors in all matters relating to the above. Players also agree that they may be subjected to Medical Examination in case of doubt for age. A participant's refusal to any of the above clauses may attract suspension or dismissal from the competition.
